



**Direct Recruitment to the posts of Forest Ranger
Forest Department, Govt. of Tripura.**

'ON-LINE APPLICATIONS (Computerized)' are invited from the eligible candidates for appearing at the Competitive Examination followed by Interview for appointment to the posts of Forest Ranger who will be required to undergo Ranger's Course Training for 18(eighteen) months outside the state. The necessary particulars are noted below:-

2. Vacancies (all pmt.): 09 (nine) [ST-02, SC-02 & UR-05]. The number of posts may be increase or decrease. The ST/SC Candidates of other States (not recognized by the Govt. of Tripura) should apply for unreserved vacancy as general candidate along with recruitment fee prescribed for general candidates.

3. Scale of pay: Pay Band-2, Rs.5310-24,000/- Grade Pay Rs.2400/- Group- C, Non Gazetted).

4. Eligibility Conditions:

(a) Citizen of India.

(b) Educational Qualifications: Bachelors Degree (or equivalent) in Science or Engineering of any recognized University with at least one of the following subjects:-

(i) Agriculture, (ii) Botany, (iii) Chemistry, (iv) Computer applications/Computer Science, (v) Engineering (Civil / Mechanical / Electrical / Electronics / Chemical / Agriculture / Computer) (vi) Environmental Science, (vii) Forestry, (viii) Geology, (ix) Horticulture, (x) Mathematics, (xi) Statistics, (xii) Physics, (xiii) Veterinary Science, (xiv) Zoology.

(d) Age:- Not more than 37 (thirty seven) years as on **14-06-2010**. Relaxable by 5(five) years in case of ST/SC/PH candidates & Government Servants provided that the Govt. Servants belonging to ST, SC & PH categories shall not get this relaxation over and above the general relaxation of 5 years available to them. The date of birth should be written in Christian era as recorded in Admit Card of Madhyamik/ School leaving Certificate Examination.

(5) How to apply:

(a) Recruitment Fee Deposit:

(b) On-line log-in (TPSC Website): The applicants shall log-in to <http://www.tpsc.gov.in> and the particulars / Bio-data in the Web page are to be entered along with the scanned **stamp/passport size photograph** with full signature at the below/ right side of the photograph.

(c) Acknowledgement Receipt: After entering the required particulars along with scanned photograph and full signature of the candidate, click save and print out to be made of the '**ON-LINE APPLICATION**' Generated Receipt.

(d) In addition to the submission of 'ON-LINE APPLICATION' within the stipulated period, In-service candidates will have to submit 'No Objection' from the Appointing Authority along with copy of on-line application receipt before the Examination/Interview.

(6) Last (Closing) Date & Time: The last date of receiving 'On-Line Application' is **14-06-2010 (5.00 pm)**

Applications received after the closing date & hour will not be entertained. Incomplete application is liable to be summarily rejected.

7. Syllabus for Examination and other Rules and Regulations

i. The examination shall be of two parts- Written examination and Interview .The Written Examination and Interview will carry 600 marks and 75 marks respectively.

ii. Provided that no candidate shall be allowed to take more than one subjects of the following Group: -

- (a) Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering and Veterinary Science
- (b) Chemistry and Chemical Engineering

- (c) Computer Applications/Computer Science and Computer Engineering
- (d) Electrical Engineering and Electronics Engineering
- (e) Mathematics and Statistics.

iii. The Standard of the Examination will be of Bachelors degree or equivalent.

iv. The question except English subject shall be answered either in English or in Bengali.

v. Pattern of question: The question except English subject will be set in objective type/short answer type/short essay type and essay type.

8. Other important decisions.

a. The candidates not having the prescribed minimum physical standard need not apply. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to establish that he is having the prescribed minimum physical standard if and when necessary.

b. The applicants must be in possession of the prescribed minimum qualification(s) for the respective post(s) as on **14-06-2010** for submission of application as mentioned in the advertisement.

c. The candidates will be responsible for correctness of all particulars as furnished. In case of any subsequent detection of false or defective statement(s) or suppression of facts, even after selection / appointment, his/her Candidature will be summarily rejected.

d. If a candidate submits more than one "On-line Applications", his/her latest application will be considered and previous applications will be automatically deleted.

e. The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility or otherwise of a candidate at any stage of the selection process shall be final.

f. The date, time, venue of the Written Competitive Examination will be notified in News papers / other media/ TPSC website in due course and **Provisional Call Letter** will be issued to the eligible candidates to appear at Written Competitive Examination. The candidates are to come along with 2(two) copies of his/her recent **stamp/passport size photographs** & Recruitment fee deposit slip (Bank receipt) for admission to the Examination Hall.

g. The Commission at its discretion may fix the minimum qualifying marks in order of merit in any or all of the written papers and in the aggregate to restrict the numbers of candidates for Personality Test/Interview. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks in any paper, so fixed, the marks in that paper will not be considered in calculation of the aggregate.

h. In no case, a candidate will be considered for interview unless he/she appears in all the papers of the written examination. If a candidate remains absent in the interview, his/her candidature will not be considered for final selection.

i. The final selection will be made in order of merit on the basis of the marks obtained by a candidate in written examination, in aggregate, adding the marks obtained in the Interview.

j. No TA/DA for the candidates will be borne by the Commission.

k. Canvassing in any form at any stage will disqualify a candidate.
