

**DIRECT RECRUITMENT FOR SCHEDULED EXAMINATION**

Applications in prescribed forms are invited from the bonafied Indian Nationals for selection of candidates for the under mentioned posts under the Govt. of Tripura.

**Item No.1:-** 103 (One Hundred and Three) pmt. posts of **Sub-Inspector of Police**, Group-C Non-Gazetted in the Scale of Rs.5,000-10,300 (pre-revised) under the Home (Police) Department. The vacancies positions with break-up are in the table:

**(i) Age:** Not below 21 years and not above 27 years as on 01-01-2009. Uper age limit is relaxable by 5 (five) years in case of ST/SC candidates. In case of Ex-Serviceman, the age is relaxable as per Memo No. F. 14(19)-P/84 dated 09.04.1985 issued by the Political Department, Govt. of Tripura.

**(ii) Physical Measurement for Men:**

**(a) Height:** 168.00 cms. Relaxable upto 163.00 cms for ST candidates.

**(b) Chest:** 79.00 cms. (Unexpanded) and 84.00 cms. (Expanded) for those heights of 168.00 cms. and above 76.00 cms (unexpanded) and 81.00 cms (expanded) for those with lesser height.

**(c) Body Weight:** Body weight shall be determined according to the Body Mass Index (BMI) between 18.5 and 29.5.

**(iii) Physical Measurement for Women:**

**(a) Height:** 152.00 cms.

**(b) Body Weight:** Body weight shall be determined according to the Body Mass Index (BMI) between 18.5 and 29.5.

**(iv) Essential Qualification for Men and Women:**

**(a)** Citizen of India.

**(b)** At least Graduate in any discipline from a recognized University.

**Desirable:** Knowledge of Bengali/Kokborok.

**(v)** Candidates possessing the essential qualifications will be required to pass a Physical Efficiency Test to be conducted by the Police Department, on the following events with the minimum One Star Standard of the National Physical Efficiency Test as fixed by the Government of India, Ministry of Education: -

**(vi)** Candidates qualified in the Physical Efficiency Test will be required to sit for a Written Examination, Subject, Full Marks and Duration of the Written Examinations are as follows: -

(vii) The candidates selected on result of Written Examination will have to appear the Personality Test of **full marks 50**.

(viii) Questions of Written Paper-I shall be answered in English and Questions of Written Paper-II may be answered either in English or Bengali.

(ix) Standard of Written Papers will be that of the Degree Pass Course Examination of an Indian University.

(x) The selection will be made in order of merit on the basis of the marks obtained by the candidates in aggregate adding the marks obtained in the Written Examination and the Personality Test. If a candidate remains absent in the Personality Test, his/her candidature will not be considered for final selection.

(xi) The Commission at its discretion may fix the minimum qualifying marks in order of merit in any or all of the written papers and in the aggregate to restrict the numbers of candidates for Personality Test. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks in any paper, so fixed, the marks in that paper will not be considered in calculation of the aggregate.

**Item No.2:- 8 (eight) pmt. posts (UR=01, SC=02 & ST=05) of Tripura Judicial Service Grade-III, Group-B Gazetted under Law Department, Govt. of Tripura in the Scale of Rs.9,000-14,550/- (pre-revised) plus admissible allowances. As per Rule-8 of the TJS Rules, 2003 posts reserved for ST and SC candidates will be filled by UR candidates if no suitable reserved category candidate is found.**

**ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:** (i) Citizen of India, (ii) Degree in Law of a recognized university.

**Age:** Upto 38 years for ST/SC candidates and 35 years for others as on 15-06-2009.(closing date)

**DISQUALIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT:-** No person shall be eligible for appointment to the service- (i) If he/she is dismissed from service by any High Court, Government or Statutory or local Authority. (ii) If he/she has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude or who is or has been permanently debarred or disqualified by the High Court or the UPSC or any State Public Service Commission from appearing in any Examination or selection conducted by it. (iii) If he/she directly or indirectly tries to influence or influences the recruiting authority by any means for his/her candidature. (iv) If he/she has more than one spouse living.

Questions of written part should be answered in English only.

(i) The selection of candidates shall be made on the basis of cumulative grade value obtained in the written and viva-voce examination.

(ii) All candidates who obtained sixty percent (60%) or more or corresponding grade in the written examination shall be eligible for viva-voce examination. Provided that Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes candidates who obtain fifty percent (50%) or more or corresponding grade in the written examination shall be eligible for viva-voce examination.

#### **Common Important Information**

The number of posts to be filled up is subject to increase or decrease following requirement of the Department.

The last date of receiving application is **15.06.2009**. The application received after the closing date will not be entertained.

**(A) Prescribed Form availability:** The 4(four) pages printed application Form will be available from any of the total 103 Nos. of Branches/Extension counters of **Tripura Gramin Bank** located at different places of Urban and Rural areas in the State of Tripura on deposit of the prescribed **Recruitment Fee through the Special Deposit Slip to the Account No. 14711 in favour of the Secretary, T.P.S.C.** in the same Branch / Extension counter as a single window system without any extra charge/Commission from the candidates.

For the candidates outside of the State, the said prescribed Form can also be down loaded from the Website <http://www.tpsc.gov.in> or <http://www.tripurainfo.com> and in that case, the **Prescribed Recruitment Fee is to be paid in the form of demand draft of any Nationalized Bank payable at Agartala in favour of the Secretary, T.P.S.C.** The said demand draft is to be enclosed with the filled up application form with record in the specified Box on the 1<sup>st</sup> page of the Form.

**(C)** ST/SC Candidates of other States (not recognized by the Govt. of Tripura) should apply for unreserved vacancy as general candidate along with recruitment fee prescribed for general candidates.

**(D)** The applicants must be in possession of the prescribed minimum qualification(s) for the respective post(s) on the closing date for submission of application as mentioned in the advertisement.

The application in the prescribed form duly filled in by the candidate and 2(two) copies of recent stamp size photographs of the candidate affixed on the Application and Admit Card along with the copies of self attested certificates as noted in the application form is to be submitted.

Any application incomplete in any form or defective or containing statements which are incorrect or false or if there is any suppression of facts, are liable to be summarily rejected. No correspondence or queries from applicants will be entertained. Canvassing in any form will disqualify a candidate.

**(E)** The candidates are also required to attach to the application; a self-addressed Post-card indicating the Advertisement No., Item No. and name of the post applied for. Application will be acknowledged by the Commission by returning this card to the candidates after indicating the Registration No. allotted to the candidates. No separate acknowledgement other than this card will be sent to them.

**(F)** The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility or otherwise of a candidate at any stage of the selection process shall be the final.

**(G)** Date, time and venue of Written Examination of the eligible qualified candidates will be notified in due course.
