It is for information of all concerned that the Commission is pleased to adopt recommendation of Expert Committee in order to determine API score of a candidate, which is to be calculated on the basis of minimum qualification as stipulated in the UGC Regulations, 2010 (Appendix-III, Table-C).

Academic performance of the candidates who have applied for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor, Government General Degree Colleges of Tripura shall be assessed based on 50 points scale. The distribution of points will be as follows.
